Read Luke 24:25-27

- We see that Jesus shows himself to the two throughout scripture. Is it foolish to make false assumptions about who Jesus is?
- Do you feel that it is wise to search the scriptures to get a better understanding of who Jesus is?
- If we don't search the scriptures in our pursuit of Him, does it stand to reason that we are inventing who Jesus is? What are the dangers in doing this (consider the men who didn't recognize Jesus)?
