

We are excited to be on this great adventure with you. You are a special part of the plan of God for our region. You are loved.



I Praise God for the amazing women that are part of Abundant Life Fellowships Church Family.

I took on the Women's Ministry in April of 2022. The previous nine months seem to have just flown by. The Women's Ministry includes all women who attend Abundant Life Fellowship Church.

To accomplish this desire, my first is to further reach out and gather women who love Jesus and have a heart for women's ministry here at ALF and the greater community. There is another thought I've been contemplating and praying about. It is in the area of the "older teaching the younger" here at ALF and perhaps beyond. Seeds are meant for spreading! To the older, God has gifted you, He has called us all to be servants, share your ability to cook with another younger person, teach them how you study God's Word... such great things will come when we step outside our comfort zone. I need this, too.
